Overview: The Lightweight Exposure Suit provides low volume rain protection in a mountainous environment.

Features: The jacket and trousers are durable overgarments, designed to quickly be donned and doffed. It is constructed out of fabric that provides rain protection and is water vapor permeable to minimize overheating when engaged in strenuous activities. Streamlined design to minimize additional weight and includes features to enable quick donning/doffing over multiple clothing layers. Exposed stitching is waterproof and guaranteed for the life of the garment. Garments are constructed with abrasion resistant knee and seat reinforcement patches.
