- Inclement Weather Combat Shirt (IWCS)
 - Currently in source selection
- FROG Fabric RFI
 - protection, durability, and comfort improvement
- Transition silk-weight and mid-weight fleece from STAP (Special Training Allowance Pool) to CIF (Consolidated Issue Facility)
